Statement of Faith

The basis of Stone Ridge Christian High School is the Word of God as interpreted by the following statement of faith. We believe....

1. God the Father

That God is the Creator and Ruler of the universe. He eternally exists in three persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. These three are co-equal, co-eternal and are one God. (Genesis 1:1,2; Matthew 28:19; John 1:3)

2. God the Son

That Jesus Christ is the Son of God. He is co-equal with the Father and possesses all the attributes of deity. (Matthew 1:22, 23; John 1:1; John 10:30-33)

3. God the Holy Spirit

That the Holy Spirit is co-equal with the Father and is a divine person possessing all of the attributes of God. (John 14:16,17; Acts 5:3,4)

4. The Bible

That the Bible is the inspired, infallible, authoritative, inerrant Word of God. (II Timothy 3:16; II Peter 1:20, 21)

5. Man

That man was made in the spiritual image of God, to be like Him in character. Man's sin has separated him from God. (Genesis 1:27; Romans 3:23)

Since I will be working with children, I understand that I must submit to a fingerprint check by the FBI and possibly other federal and state authorities. I agree to fully cooperate in providing and recording as many sets of my fingerprints as are necessary for such an investigation. I authorize the school to conduct a criminal records check. I understand and agree that any offer of employment that I may receive from the school is conditioned upon the receipt of background information, including criminal background information. The school may refuse employment or terminate conditional employment if the school deems any background information unfavorable or that it could reflect adversely on the school or on me as a Christian role model.
